House Rules

The Hiswa harbor and shipyard regulations apply; in addition, the following applies:

- For safety reasons, the use of wood-burning stoves is not permitted.
- When performing any work on the boat, such as painting, sanding, or scraping, a tarpaulin must be laid underneath to prevent soiling. Take wind and rain into account when carrying out this work. You are responsible for removing any dirt you create under and around your boat. If we are required to clean it due to a report, you will be responsible for the associated costs.
- Machine sanding is only permitted if the corresponding dust extraction system is installed. A dust bag alone is not sufficient. Always dispose of dust residue in a double-layered garbage bag.
- Private bollards, stairs, or other objects may not be attached to the dock without the marina's written permission. Should we discover such a violation, we will file a report for vandalism and terminate the contract. The boat must leave the harbor immediately; mooring fees will not be refunded.
- Rinsing paintbrushes in the toilet block sinks is prohibited.
- Hoisting sails when the boat is on a cradle is prohibited, climbing the mast when the boat is ashore is forbidden as well.
- Crane operations with a rigged jib or furling mainsail are not permitted.
- Disposing of chemical waste such as leftover paint and/or brushes, polyester remnants, or used oil in the waste containers is prohibited. These can be disposed of at the chemical container at the roundabout. Defective batteries can be handed in to a Waterland employee.
- If anyone other than the owner or a contracted company performs work on the boat, a Risk Assessment & Evaluation (RI&E) form must be completed at the harbor office. If no form is submitted, the owner is liable in the event of damage.
- Crane and transport operations are carried out at your own risk. The lifting points on the vessel must be clearly marked.
- Has your boat been serviced and needs to be relaunched? No cash = no splash.
- Bicycles, dinghies, and trailers without a valid inspection sticker will be removed. Annual badges can be obtained at the harbour office.
